# Welcome to Summer Boys & Girls Club Programs!

Program participants will enjoy activities designed around fun themes, as well as programs that build Academic Success, Good Character and Citizenship and Healthy Lifestyles.

The clubhouse **Day Camp** operates between 9:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, June 18 – August 24, 2018. Participants are placed in age appropriate groups that follow a daily schedule of activities. Lunch and snack are provided to all participants. The **Sunrise Program** runs 7:00 – 9:00a.m. and includes breakfast.

**Camp Registration is open to all Club members!** Not a member yet? Pick up a registration packet at your local Club and attend a Parent Orientation. Annual membership (September – August) fee is only \$20.

<b>Teen Camp</b> (noon – 6:00p.m.) Students entering Gr. 8-12 (Fall 2018)	\$25/week per member (non-LITs) Lunch and snack included
<b>Leaders in Training</b> (7:00a.m. – noon) Students entering Gr. 8-12 (Fall 2018) (by application only)	\$25/week per member Breakfast and lunch included <i>LITs in good standing may add on Teen Camp for only \$5/week!</i>

## Field Trips

Field Trip information will be available May 1<sup>st</sup> at the Clubs. There is a \$10 weekly field trip fee for members. Permission slips will be available at 3:00p.m. on Thursdays prior to the Field Trip week. Week 1 field trip permission slips will be available at 3:00p.m. on Monday, June 18<sup>th</sup> at your designated Summer Program Site. All field trip registrations are on a first come, first served basis.

**Additional field trips** may be available throughout the summer at little or no cost to members.

## Registration Procedures

Camp Registration forms are available at all Boys & Girls Clubs of Spokane County Clubhouses. Forms are available online to download and print at [www.bgcspokanecounty.org](http://www.bgcspokanecounty.org).

All campers must be enrolled as current members of the Boys & Girls Clubs of Spokane County and have an up-to-date account in order to enroll in the 2018 Summer Day Camp. A parent/guardian must attend a Parent Orientation (for new and renewing members) before membership application will be processed. Please call Club to confirm orientation dates and times.

**New for 2018!** Online registration is available for the 2018 Summer Camps! Access your Club's online registration portal at [www.bgcspokanecounty.org](http://www.bgcspokanecounty.org). Information on how to access the Online Registration Portal is available at your Club's Front Desk. If you would like help setting up your online account, our Front Desk is happy to help you. Please contact us if you are having trouble logging in. Credit or debit card payment is required with online registration. Discounts are not yet available through online registration (i.e. military/insurance membership discounts, fee waivers and free/reduced eligible discounts).

## Payments

All weekly fees must be paid *no later than* the Thursday prior to any camp week. **Only complete registrations with payment will be processed.** Failure to pay will result in forfeiture of camp spot in coming weeks. Payments are only accepted in person or through online registration portal. Please do not mail payments. **All fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.**

## Fee Assistance

Boys & Girls Clubs of Spokane County strives to provide the highest quality, most affordable summer program in our community. We recognize that some families may need assistance with summer program fees. Fee Waivers may be requested at the time of registration and are awarded by Clubhouse Directors based on a family's individual need.

## Refunds

All fees (membership, program and field trip fees) are non-refundable. No refunds will be given if a camper does not attend a registered session/week of camp or leaves early for any reason (including suspension from Club). Partial refunds may be issued at the discretion of Club Director for extreme circumstances (such as: Club closure due to weather, family emergencies, etc.). Parent/guardian may make a refund request in writing no later than August 31, 2018.
